

## English

**Language** – Understand how texts vary in purpose, structure and topic as well as the degree of formality. Understand the difference between main and subordinate clauses and that a complex sentence involves at least one subordinate clause.

**Literature** - Understand, interpret and experiment with a range of devices and deliberate word play in poetry and other literary texts, for example nonsense words, spoonerisms, neologisms and puns. Create literary texts that experiment with structures, ideas and stylistic features of selected authors.

**Literacy** - Plan, rehearse and deliver presentations incorporating learned content and taking into account the particular purposes and audiences. Navigate and read texts for specific purposes applying appropriate text processing strategies, such as predicting and confirming, monitoring meaning, skimming and scanning.

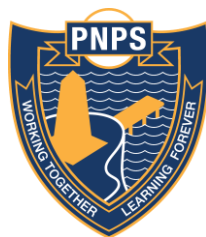
## Maths

**Number and Algebra** – Investigate number sequences involving multiples of 3, 4, 6, 7, 8, and 9. Solve problems involving division by a one digit number, including those that result in a remainder. Compare and order decimals.

**Measurement and Geometry** - Compare objects using familiar metric units of area and volume. Calculate perimeter and area of rectangles using familiar metric units. Compare and describe two dimensional shapes. Connect three-dimensional objects with their nets and other two-dimensional representations.

**Statistics and Probability** - Describe possible everyday events and order their chances of occurring. List outcomes of chance experiments involving equally likely outcomes and represent probabilities of those outcomes using fractions.
