It is a world-class, evidence-based child safety program that is used by a range of other Australian and international schools.






# LITERACY PRO

Literacy Pro™ is an online assessment and reading programme which supports teachers in nurturing proficient readers.

The platform measures pupils' reading abilities via the Lexile® framework and features an online library of diverse reading materials with accompanying quizzes to support independent reading.

Literacy Pro measures reading comprehension and identifies books to promote reading growth in each student.
